BCOR withstands even the most stringent test methods, namely a 48-hour NSS (neutral salt spray) test and a 24-hour AASS (acetic acid salt spray) test as per DIN EN ISO 9227. Various independent international institutes also attest to the fact that BCOR provides great protection.
